

## 2017 Pitt Community College Student Achievement Results

The Performance Measures for Student Success are Pitt Community College’s major accountability document demonstrating Student Achievement. This annual performance report is based on data compiled from the previous year and serves to inform the College and its publics about its performance on a variety of student success factors. Student achievement is central to the College’s mission and the criteria selected spans the many opportunities available to Pitt Community College students. The College collaborates with staff at the NC Community College System office to collect, report, and publish this information. Results for 2017 are illustrated below.

### Important Notes:

1. Use of “baselines” and “goals” is employed for each measure. The use of consistent, statistically-defined baselines and goals promotes institutional transparency, simplicity, and objectivity.
2. Based on three years of historical data (if available) for each measure, baselines were set two standard deviations below the system mean, and the goals were set one standard deviation above the system mean.
