

Application for NC Residency

If you are completing an online application for admission to PCC and don't already have a Residency Certificate Number (RCN), you will apply for residency determination at the same time as you complete your admissions application on the CFNC website.

If you already have an RCN number, you will need to provide this number on your admissions application.

To apply for residency you will need to have the following information:

- ✓ Student's Personal Identifying information (SSN, ARN, SCIS, or ITIN)
- ✓ Parent's Personal Identifying information (SSN, ARN, USCIS, or ITIN)
 - RDS validates the information you enter into the RDS online interview through database matches with certain North Carolina state agencies. Your SSN is critical to this validation. If you cannot (or will not) provide an SSN, RDS classifies you as out-of-state and you must then request an Appeal, which requires submission of paper identification.
- ✓ Student and/or Parent(s) federal tax information
- ✓ Student and/or Parent(s) State tax information
- ✓ Permanent Residence information
- ✓ Vehicle or Driver's License information
- ✓ Military information (if applicable)
- ✓ US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) Documentation (if applicable)

Note that all items may not be required for all students, depending on individual circumstances. This is not an exhaustive list as additional documentation may be required from some applicants.
