

## Pitt Community College 2015-2016 Planning Year Timeline

Assessing institutional effectiveness (IE) is a cyclical process. An illustration of the College’s annual institutional effectiveness cycle is provided to generally depict the sequence of recurring IE processual tasks (Boone, 1992) within the IE process. These tasks are directly related to compliance with SACSCOC requirements and standards within the 2.5 and 3.3.1 series.
