Computer Skills Placement Test (given at PCC only)	
CIS 070	Score of 15 or less
No developmental computer coursework needed	16-25

**To be exempt from the computer skills placement test and CIS-070, students must meet one of the criteria below (proper documentation must be on file):**

- Acceptable placement test scores
- Student meets requirements for Multiple Measures
- CLEP Information Systems and Computer Applications score of 50 or higher
- IC3 Certification
- Successfully completed Computer Applications 1 and 2 in high school
- Student has transfer credit for CIS 070, CIS 110, CIS 111, or WEB 110
- Student has a GRE score in the 30th percentile or higher on the Quantitative section and testing was completed within the past five years.
- **Post-secondary degree from an accredited institution**

**Note:** All students must take the Computer Skills Placement Test through PCC.

- If a student has tested at another institution, they have probably not completed the Computer Skills Placement Test and should be sent to the Testing Office with a photo ID to test (this test runs about 5 minutes).
- Distance Learning students or students who live out of town may complete this test at another institution by completing and submitting a [Proctor Verification Form](#) to the Testing Office.
