Submit an official high school transcript or high school equivalency scores.

High school transcripts can be submitted through your CFNC account, by working with your high school counselor or county school board.

Submit official transcripts from each post-secondary institution attended. Students are encouraged to submit official transcripts for every college or university attended. It is necessary if transfer credit is to be awarded and/or for students to meet necessary course prerequisites. Students can submit transcripts one of three ways:

Students entering a NC Community College will be placed by their unweighted high school GPA into one of three categories.

- 1. Students with a 2.8 or higher GPA may register for college level courses without mandatory additional support.
- 2. Students with a 2.2-2.799 may register for a gateway course with a mandatory support course.
- 3. Students with a 2.2 or less will be required to enroll in a one-semester transition course.

Students, who have graduated from high school more than 10 years ago, will be required to take the RISE placement test unless they meet certain criteria.

Placement Testing is located in the Warren Building, Room 2402. A Photo ID will be required to take the placement test. For more information, please contact Placement Testing at 252-493-7561 or pcctesting@my.pittcc.edu.
