SPRING 2022 SCHOLARSHIP

MAYNE PHARMA SCHOLARS PROGRAM at Pitt Community College

Eight PCC AAS Biotechnology students will once again be selected to be **Mayne Pharma Scholars** in the **Spring of 2022**. These students will be selected from Pitt County High School Seniors and current PCC students. Students will be required to submit high school and/or current college transcripts, CRC scores (or ACT scores), and fill out an application. **Application deadline is November 5, 2021**. The top 15 candidates will be selected as semi-finalists and will be invited to submit a recommendation letter from a teacher and participate in an interview.

Mayne Pharma Scholars will be awarded a **full scholarship** for **two years**. The estimated amount is **\$8000 total per student**.

- Full Scholarship for Biotechnology AAS Degree covering books, tuition, and fees for 5 consecutive semesters offered by Mayne Pharma, Inc.
- Biotechnology AAS Degree program is a laboratory-intensive program that trains students to be lab analysts in the pharmaceutical industry.
- Scholars will have an opportunity for a paid full-time internship at MaynePharma during the summer between their first and second year and a part-time paid internship during their second year.
- Current high school seniors and current PCC students with an aptitude for science are encouraged to apply.
