Narrative:

Oceanside College enlisted the services of FinanceAid in 2018 to conduct loan counseling, deferment/forbearance options, loan forgiveness and default management services. The college also utilizes CourseCoin, a free online financial education resource designed specifically for college and university students, in all student introduction to college courses. Through CourseCoin, students are assigned financial literacy assignments including student loan debt counseling. The institution requires students to complete a “Loan Acceptance Form” prior to the receipt of any loans to further educate on loan requirements. Exit Counseling is sent each semester to necessary students and their student portal. Another online system for students, Self Service, has been updated to show real time data of a student’s borrowing history. This feature also explains a student’s loan in detail and links them to studentaid.gov for additional information.
