New Hampshire	*		Pharmacy technicians are regulated in New Hampshire. Certification is, however, not required to practice as a pharmacy technician. The New Hampshire State Board of Pharmacy has approved both the PTCB exam and the ExCPT for candidates to take, if they wish. Before commencing employment, candidates must first register with the State Board of Pharmacy.

New Mexico	*		The New Mexico State Board of Pharmacy have approved both the PTCB exam and the ExCPT for candidates to take, if they wish. Candidates who are not nationally certified must complete State approved training and complete 220 hours hours of technician-related work. They must also complete the PTCB test or ExCPT within 1-year. Before commencing employment, candidates must first register with the State Board of Pharmacy.
